

## CHANNEL ONE NEWS SHOW SCRIPT 10/8/07

TONY: HEY GUYS! IT IS MONDAY- OCTOBER EIGHTH, 2007. I'M TONY ANDERSON, AND YOU'RE WATCHING CHANNEL ONE NEWS.

(SOT: MARION JONES)- "I WANT YOU TO KNOW THAT I HAVE BEEN DISHONEST AND YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE ANGRY WITH ME."

ANNOUNCER: TRACK STAR MARION JONES WON FIVE OLYMPIC MEDALS IN 2000. NOW SHE'S ADMITTED TO USING ANABOLIC STEROIDS AND COULD FACE FELONY CHARGES.

ANNOUNCER: FOR YEARS, JONES DENIED RUMORED STEROID USE BUT ON FRIDAY, SHE FESSED UP TO USING THE PERFORMANCE ENHANCING DRUG KNOWN AS 'THE CLEAR' BEFORE THE SYDNEY OLYMPICS.

ANNOUNCER: 'THE CLEAR' INCREASES STRENGTH BY BUILDING MUSCLE AND BURNING FAT. IT IS BANNED BY THE FEDERAL DRUG ADMINISTRATION. IN 2003, JONES TOLD FEDERAL INVESTIGATORS THAT SHE HAD **NEVER** USED STEROIDS. SHE COULD FACE JAIL TIME FOR LYING. STEROIDS CAN ENHANCE PERFORMANCE, BUT ACCORDING TO THE NCAA (N-C-DOUBLE-A), THEY CAN ALSO CAUSE BALDNESS, DEPRESSION AND AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR.

JESSICA: GENERAL PERVEZ MUSHARRAF SWEEPED PAKISTAN'S PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION ON SATURDAY. NOW IT'S UP TO PAKISTAN'S SUPREME COURT TO DECIDE WHETHER TO UPHOLD HIS VICTORY.

JESSICA: THE OPPOSITION - THE PAKISTAN PEOPLE'S PARTY - HAS CHALLENGED THE ELECTION, CLAIMING IT WAS UNFAIR AND UNDEMOCRATIC. THE OPPOSITION SAYS THE NEWLY ELECTED PRESIDENT SHOULD NOT HAVE BEEN ALLOWED TO KEEP HIS JOB AS CHIEF OF THE ARMY WHILE RUNNING FOR PRESIDENT. MUSHARRAF PROMISED TO STEP DOWN FROM HIS MILITARY JOB IF HE WON. IF THE SUPREME COURT UPHOLDS THE DECISION, MUSHARRAF WILL SERVE A FIVE-YEAR TERM.

ANNOUNCER: IN CHINA, ONE-POINT-FOUR MILLION PEOPLE WERE EVACUATED AS TYPHOON KROSA MADE LANDFALL SUNDAY.

ANNOUNCER: WINDS REACHED ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SIX MILES PER HOUR AS KROSA CRASHED INTO THE CHINESE COAST. THE STORM HAS SINCE WEAKENED. KROSA HIT TAIWAN ON SATURDAY WHERE THERE WERE FIVE DEATHS REPORTED FROM THE STORM. A TYPHOON IS A STORM THAT OCCURS IN THE NORTHWEST PACIFIC OCEAN WITH WINDS OF SEVENTY-FOUR MILES PER HOUR OR MORE. IF THE SAME STORM OCCURS IN THE ATLANTIC OCEAN, IT'S CALLED A HURRICANE.

JESSICA: MEAT LOVERS BEWARE; ANOTHER BEEF COMPANY HAS ISSUED A NATIONWIDE RECALL. CARGILL INCORPORATED VOLUNTARILY RECALLED SOME OF ITS MEAT AFTER FOUR CASES OF E. COLI INFECTION WERE TRACED BACK TO THE COMPANY'S FROZEN BURGERS.

JESSICA: CARGILL HAS ASKED CUSTOMERS TO RETURN OR DESTROY ANY BEEF PATTIES PURCHASED AFTER AUGUST 26TH. CARGILL HAMBURGER MEAT IS SOLD AT SAM'S CLUB. THIS YEAR HAS SEEN AN UNUSUALLY HIGH NUMBER OF E. COLI INFECTIONS AND MEAT RECALLS. LAST WEEK, TOPPS MEAT COMPANY RECALLED MORE THAN 21-POINT SEVEN MILLION POUNDS OF FROZEN HAMBURGERS.

JESSICA: E. COLI IS A BACTERIA THAT IS FOUND IN THE INTESTINES OF MANY ANIMALS. ACCORDING TO THE CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL, EATING MEAT THAT HAS NOT BEEN SUFFICIENTLY COOKED TO KILL E. COLI CAN CAUSE SERIOUS INFECTION.

ANNOUNCER: YOU MAY WANT TO THINK TWICE BEFORE YOU HEAD TO KAZAA (KUH-KAH) OR LIMEWIRE TO DOWNLOAD YOUR NEW FAVORITE SONG FOR FREE. A FEDERAL COURT HAS ORDERED MINNESOTA MOM, JAMMIE (PRONOUNCED JAMIE) THOMAS, TO PAY 220-THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR ILLEGALLY SHARING 24-SONGS. THAT'S A NINE-THOUSAND 250-DOLLAR FINE PER SONG.

ANNOUNCER: THE RECORDING INDUSTRY OF AMERICA HAS FILED 26-THOUSAND LAWSUITS FOR ILLEGAL DOWNLOADING SINCE 2003, BUT THOMAS' TRIAL MARKED THE FIRST TIME THAT A MUSIC DOWNLOADING CASE WAS HEARD BY A JURY.

(POSSIBLE SOT: JAMMIE THOMAS, DEFENDANT) - "I DID NOT DOWNLOAD ANY MUSIC. I DID NOT DOWNLOAD OR UPLOAD ANY MUSIC, PERIOD."

CHRIS: HEY GUYS IT'S CHRIS BROWNE, AND I'M AT THE SEED PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL IN WASHINGTON D.C., AND COMING UP, YOU'LL SEE MY ONE-ON-ONE INTERVIEW WITH JENNA BUSH.

[COMMERCIAL]

CHRIS: YOU MAY ALREADY KNOW JENNA BUSH AS THE DAUGHTER OF THE FIRST LADY AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES. BUT DID YOU KNOW SHE'S ALSO A TEACHER, A UNICEF VOLUNTEER, AND AN AUTHOR? AND AS I FOUND OUT, SHE'S WRITING ABOUT SOME OF THE TOUGH ISSUES FACING TEENS IN THE DEVELOPING WORLD.

CHRIS: AT FIRST GLANCE, IT SEEMS JENNA BUSH AND ANA, THE MAIN CHARACTER IN HER BOOK "ANA'S STORY: A JOURNEY OF HOPE," HAVE VERY LITTLE IN COMMON. ANA IS A 17-YEAR-OLD GIRL WHO LIVES IN LATIN AMERICA. BOTH OF ANA'S PARENTS DIED OF AIDS, AND ANA, WHO HAS A YOUNG DAUGHTER, NOW LIVES WITH THE DISEASE. BUT DESPITE THE DIFFERENCES, JENNA SAYS THE TWO YOUNG WOMEN FORGED AN UNFORGETTABLE FRIENDSHIP.

>>(SOT: JENNA BUSH): "ANA CHANGED MY LIFE, SHE IS ONLY 17, BUT SHE HAS LIVED THE LIFE OF SOMEONE SO MUCH OLDER."

CHRIS: I MET JENNA AT THE SEED PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL IN WASHINGTON D.C., WHERE SHE WAS TALKING TO A GROUP OF 11TH AND 12TH GRADERS ABOUT ANA'S STORY. I ASKED HER WHAT IT WAS LIKE TO WRITE ABOUT SOMEONE TO WHOM SHE FELT SO CONNECTED.

>>(SOT: JENNA, BUSH): "YEAH, IT WAS VERY DIFFICULT AND I WILL SAY, OF COURSE, I WAS BIASED BECAUSE I CARED ABOUT HER. BUT AT THE SAME TIME, I TRIED TO WRITE IT WITHOUT JUDGMENT, AND I TRIED TO WRITE IT AS STRAIGHTFORWARD AS I POSSIBLY COULD."

CHRIS: SHE SAYS THAT ANA, ALTHOUGH SHE DID NOT WANT HER REAL NAME USED IN THE BOOK, ENCOURAGED JENNA TO USE HER STORY AS A WAY OF INSPIRING TEENS HERE IN THE UNITED STATES.

CHRIS: "AND YOU'RE MEETING KIDS, AND I ACTUALLY SPOKE TO SOM KIDSE, WHO ARE DEALING WITH THE SAME KINDS OF ISSUES THAT ANA WAS FACING. THAT MUST BE AMAZING FOR YOU."

>> (SOT: JENNA BUSH)- "YEAH. AND I FEEL THAT'S ONE OF THE REASONS WHY I WANTED TO DO THIS AND WHY ANA ENCOURAGED ME TO DO IT IS THAT, OBVIOUSLY, PROBLEMS LIKE THIS EXIST. I THINK EITHER KIDS WILL FIND POWER FROM ANA'S STORY TO GET THE HELP THEY NEED, OR IF THEY LIVE IN SAFE HOMES AND GET A GOOD EDUCATION, THEY CAN HEAR ANA'S STORY, AND HOPEFULLY BE INSPIRED TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN THEIR COMMUNITY."

CHRIS: IT'S A MESSAGE, JENNA HOPES, WILL REALLY HIT HOME WITH TEENS.

>> (SOT: JENNA BUSH) "I KIND OF THOUGHT BACK WHEN I WAS IN HIGH SCHOOL WHICH WASN'T THAT LONG AGO, AND WHAT I KNEW AND WHAT I DIDN'T KNOW ABOUT THE PROBLEMS AROUND THE WORLD AND HOW OTHER KIDS LIVED, AND I FELT LIKE HIGH SCHOOL AND MIDDLE SCHOOL WAS A GOOD PLACE TO START TO BECOME COMPASSIONATE, GLOBAL LEADERS."

CHRIS: CHRIS BROWNE, CHANNEL ONE NEWS

ANNOUNCER: IF YOU THINK YOU HAVE WHAT IT TAKES TO BE COMMANDER IN CHIEF, HEAD TO THE CHANNEL ONE DOT COM AND TAKE OUR "COULD YOU BE PRESIDENT?" QUIZ.

YOU'VE GOT TEN SECONDS.

JESSICA: THE ANSWER IS C- ITALY.

JESSICA: EVEN THOUGH CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS LEFT SPAIN WITH THE HELP OF HIS SPONSORS, QUEEN ISABELLA AND KING FERDINAND OF SPAIN, HE WAS BORN IN ITALY. AND BY THE WAY, IN ITALIAN HIS NAME IS CRISTOFORO COLOMBO.

JESSICA: HANGING OUT AT THE MALL IS A TEEN PAST TIME; IT WAS DEFINITELY ONE OF MINE WHILE I WAS IN HIGH SCHOOL. BUT WHAT IF YOU AND YOUR FRIENDS WEREN'T ALLOWED TO HANG OUT? MORE AND MORE MALLS ACROSS THE COUNTRY ARE SETTING UP CURFEWS, AND TEENS WE TALKED TO HAVE A LOT TO SAY ABOUT IT.

>> (SOT: CANDACE TAYLOR, 18 YEARS OLD): I DON'T THINK IT SHOULD EXIST. DOESN'T MAKE SENSE TO ME."

>> (SOT:)- "I FEEL BAD FOR THE KIDS, BUT I GUESS THEY GOT TO WAIT UNTIL THEY TURN OLDER THAN 16."

JESSICA: THEY'RE TALKING ABOUT WHAT ONE ARIZONA MALL CALLS SIX-SIXTEEN. THE MALL OF AMERICA IN MINNEAPOLIS DUBS IT PEP - PARENT ESCORT POLICY. BUT WHATEVER THE NAME, IT MEANS ONE THING FOR TEENS- A CURFEW AT THE MALL.

>> (SOT: KHOU XIONG)- "WHO'S THE GUY OR GIRL WHO CAME UP WITH THIS BIG IDEA? I DON'T THINK IT'S A REALLY GOOD ONE."

JESSICA: LIKE IT OR NOT, RULES REQUIRING TEENS TO HAVE CHAPERONES AFTER CERTAIN TIMES AND ON CERTAIN DAYS ARE POPPING UP ALL OVER THE COUNTRY. AT LEAST 50 MALLS ARE DOING IT. THAT'S ACCORDING TO THE INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL OF SHOPPING CENTERS.

JESSICA: SPECIAL MALL MOMS AND SECURITY GUARDS ARE THE ONES CHECKING IDS. AT THIS MALL IN PHOENIX, TEENS UNDER 16 MUST BE WITH AN ADULT AFTER 6 PM ON THURSDAY, FRIDAY, AND SATURDAY. SOME SAY THAT DOESN'T MAKE SENSE FOR THIS OUTDOOR MALL.

>> (SOT: WILL PENTIS): "HAVING AN ADULT WITH YOU WHILE IT'S STILL LIGHT OUT KINDA DOESN'T MAKE SENSE."

>> (SOT: LAUREN ROSA): "IT'S TOO EARLY. I'D CHANGE IT TO 8 PM, BUT IT HELPS WITH THE CROWDS. THIS IS BRAND NEW SO IT'S NOT CROWDED YET."

JESSICA: SO WHY THE CURFEW HERE?

>> (SOT: STACY PEARSON, TEMPE MARKETPLACE SPOKESWOMAN)-"AT NIGHT, THE VIBE CHANGES- GETS OLDER AND BAR CROWD MOVES IN. IT MAKES SENSE TO KEEP TEENS AWAY FROM OPEN LIQUOR."

>> (SOT: UNIDENTIFIED TEEN)- "IT'S UP TO RESTAURANTS--THEY JUST HAVE TO BE RESPONSIBLE ENOUGH TO CHECK ID'S."

JESSICA: TEENS SPEND A LOT OF MONEY- BILLION DOLLARS A YEAR, SO MALLS WITH A CURFEW MAY BE MISSING OUT."

>> (SOT: UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE TEEN)- "WE'RE SHOPPING AND JUST SPENDING MONEY AND HAVING FUN."

>>(SOT: UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE TEEN)-"IT'S FUN BECAUSE I LIKE TO SHOP AND GET NEW THINGS."

TONY: "THANK YOU GUYS FOR JOINING US. I'M TONY ANSERSON. WE'LL SEE YOU HERE TOMORROW- SAME TIME, SAME PLACE."
