

## CHANNEL ONE NEWS SHOW SCRIPT 11/05/07

TONY: HEY GUYS, IT'S MONDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2007! I'M TONY ANDERSON-- CHANNEL ONE NEWS STARTS RIGHT NOW!

CHRIS: MORE THAN 3-THOUSAND YEARS AFTER HIS MYSTERIOUS DEATH, KING TUT'S FACE IS ON DISPLAY TO THE PUBLIC FOR THE FIRST TIME.

CHRIS: KING TUTANKHUMAN -- WHO'S BETTER KNOWN AS KING TUT -- WAS AN EGYPTIAN PHARAOH. ARCHAEOLOGISTS BELIEVE HE BECAME KING WHEN HE WAS 8 YEARS OLD AND LIVED UNTIL HE WAS ABOUT 19. HIS BODY WAS MUMMIFIED, AND PLACED IN A TOMB WITH GOLD AND STONE TREASURES.

CHRIS: ARCHAEOLOGISTS DISCOVERED KING TUT'S HIDDEN TOMB 85 YEARS AGO IN 19-22. ONLY ABOUT 50 PEOPLE HAD SEEN HIS FACE UNTIL NOW.

CHRIS: KING TUT'S BODY AND TOMB ARE NOW IN A CLIMATE-CONTROLLED GLASS BOX AND ON DISPLAY IN THE VALLEY OF THE KINGS IN LUXOR, EGYPT. NEXT YEAR, THE EXHIBIT WILL COME HERE TO THE U-S.

ANNOUNCER: SECRETARY OF STATE CONDOLEEZZA RICE MAY BE CALLED TO TESTIFY ABOUT HER INVOLVEMENT WITH PRO-ISRAEL LOBBYISTS.

ANNOUNCER: LOBBYISTS ARE INDIVIDUALS WHO REPRESENT SPECIFIC INTERESTS AND TRY TO INFLUENCE GOVERNMENT POLICY.

ANNOUNCER: TWO LOBBYISTS WHO USED TO WORK FOR PRO-ISRAEL GROUPS ARE FACING FEDERAL CHARGES FOR RECEIVING CLASSIFIED INFORMATION ABOUT THE U-S GOVERNMENT **AND** PASSING IT ON TO ISRAELI OFFICIALS AND THE PRESS.

ANNOUNCER: LAWYERS FOR THE LOBBYISTS' SAID THAT THE PAIR WERE PART OF TALKS ON U-S POLICYMAKING AND THAT'S WHY THEY HAD ACCESS TO THE INFORMATION.

ANNOUNCER: A FEDERAL JUDGE SAID SECRETARY RICE AND OTHER OFFICIALS COULD BE CALLED TO TESTIFY IN THE LOBBYISTS' TRIAL NEXT YEAR.

ANNOUNCER: THE STATE DEPARTMENT SAID IT WILL NOT COMMENT ON THE CASE.

ANNOUNCER: IF SECRETARY RICE AND OTHERS TESTIFY, IT COULD OFFER A BEHIND-THE-SCENES LOOK AT THE WAY U.S. FOREIGN POLICY IS CRAFTED.

CHRIS: A WEEK OF HEAVY RAINS HAS CAUSED SEVERE FLOODING IN THE MEXICAN STATE TABASCO. MORE THAN 900-THOUSAND HOMES WERE FLOODED. AND SOME RESIDENTS WERE FORCED TO SWIM THROUGH THE STREETS TO SAFETY.

CHRIS: OFFICIALS ARE ALSO CONCERNED THE CONTAMINATED WATER COULD SPREAD DISEASE. MORE RAIN IS EXPECTED IN THE COMING DAYS.

ANNOUNCER: ANOTHER ROUND OF MASSIVE MEAT RECALLS. THIS TIME, MORE THAN A MILLION POUNDS OF BEEF ARE BEING PULLED OFF SHELVES. IT'S FEARED THE BEEF COULD BE CONTAMINATED WITH E-COLI, A POTENTIALLY DEADLY BACTERIUM THAT CAN CAUSE DIARRHEA AND SEVERE DEHYDRATION.

ANNOUNCER: E-COLI LIVES IN THE INTESTINES OF ANIMALS, AND COULD GET ACCIDENTALLY MIXED INTO MEAT DURING THE PACKAGING PROCESS.

ANNOUNCER: THE MEAT WAS PRODUCED BY CARGILL REGIONAL BEEF BETWEEN, OCTOBER 8TH AND OCTOBER 11<sup>TH</sup>, AND DISTRIBUTED TO STORES ALL OVER THE COUNTRY. CARGILL IS VOLUNTARILY RECALLING THE MEAT AND WORKING WITH THE GOVERNMENT.

ANNOUNCER: TEN STATES INCLUDED IN THE RECALL -- CONNECTICUT, MAINE, MARYLAND, MASSACHUSETTS, MICHIGAN, NEW JERSEY, NEW YORK, OHIO, PENNSYLVANIA AND VIRGINIA.

CHRIS: TWO ASTRONAUTS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED ONE OF THE MOST DANGEROUS SPACEWALKS IN HISTORY OVER THE WEEKEND.

CHRIS: THE ASTRONAUTS WERE ABLE TO REPAIR A SOLAR PANEL ON THE INTERNATIONAL SPACE STATION.

CHRIS: THE SOLAR PANEL PLAYS A CRUCIAL PART OF POWERING THE SPACE STATION, AND ASTRONAUTS ARE RELIEVED THE MISSION WENT OFF WITHOUT A HITCH.

CHRIS: SOME OF THE ASTRONAUTS ARE EXPECTED TO RETURN HOME ON WEDNESDAY.

(SOT: Derek Hassman / Space Station Flight Director) "Just a fabulous day, fabulous shift and one of the greatest things I personally have been involved in."

TONY: COMING UP WE'RE GONNA TAKE YOU TO A PLACE WHERE HISTORY WAS FOUND UNDER TONS OF ROCK AND DEBRIS. IT'S AN AMAZING DISCOVERY JUST AHEAD.

TONY: THE PRESIDENT OF PAKISTAN DECLARED A STATE OF EMERGENCY ON SATURDAY, SUSPENDING THE COUNTRY'S CONSTITUTION.

TONY: HE CLAIMS IT'S A MOVE TO STOP TERRORISTS AND VIOLENCE, BUT AS CHRIS BROWNE TELLS US, MANY SEE IT A LAST GRAB AT POWER.

CHRIS: THE STREETS IN PAKISTAN'S CAPITAL OF ISLAMABAD WERE QUIET YESTERDAY, ESPECIALLY AROUND GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS WHERE PAKISTANI POLICE AND PARAMILITARY FORCES HAVE SET UP EXTRA CHECKPOINTS.

CHRIS: PRESIDENT PERVEZ MUSHARRAF, THE U.S.-BACKED MILITARY GENERAL WHO RUNS THE COUNTRY, WENT ON THE OFFENSIVE TO TRY AND PREVENT ANY POPULAR DEMONSTRATIONS OR OPPOSITION TO HIS DECISION TO IMPOSE 'MARTIAL LAW' IN PAKISTAN.

CHRIS: MARTIAL LAW IS WHEN THE MILITARY TAKES OVER THE NORMAL WAY A COUNTRY RUNS - USUALLY DURING WAR OR A CIVIL CRISIS. A COUNTRY UNDER MARTIAL LAW IS COMPLETELY GOVERNED BY THE MILITARY--COURTS, POLICE, THE LEGISLATURE, EVEN THE MEDIA ARE ALL PLACED UNDER MILITARY CONTROL.

CHRIS: THE TRANSITION TO MARTIAL LAW FOLLOWS PRESIDENT MUSHARRAF'S DECLARATION OF A "STATE OF EMERGENCY" IN PAKISTAN. ACCORDING TO THE PRIME MINISTER, PRIVATE TELEVISION STATIONS HAVE BEEN BANNED AND 400 TO 500 OPPOSITION LEADERS AND CRITICS OF MUSHARRAF ARE IN JAIL OR UNDER HOUSE ARREST. THIS IS AN ATTEMPT TO TRY AND PREVENT ANY DEMONSTRATIONS ON THE STREETS.

CHRIS: PRESIDENT MUSHARRAF HAS SAID THAT THESE EXTRAORDINARY MEASURES HAVE BEEN TAKEN TO PROTECT THIS COUNTRY'S STABILITY.

(SOT- President General Pervez Musharraf) "Pakistan is on the verge of destabilization."

CHRIS: WITHOUT MARITAL LAW PRESIDENT MUSHARRAF SAYS THE TERRORISTS AND EXTREMISTS WOULD TAKE OVER - BUT CRITICS SAY THIS IS MERELY AN ATTEMPT BY GENERAL TO STAY IN POWER.

CHRIS: NEXT WEEK THE SUPREME COURT IN PAKISTAN WAS EXPECTED TO ANNOUNCE A MAJOR DECISION POSSIBLY SAYING THAT MUSHARRAF IS NO LONGER ELIGIBLE TO REMAIN PRESIDENT OF THIS COUNTRY.

CHRIS: IN 1999, MUSHARRAF SEIZED POWER IN A MILITARY COUP. HE HAD PROMISED TO GIVE UP HIS ARMY POST AND BECOME A CIVILIAN PRESIDENT THIS YEAR--BUT THIS WEEKEND'S TURMOIL HAS DASHED HOPES FOR MANY OF A SMOOTH TRANSITION INTO DEMOCRACY FOR THE NUCLEAR-ARMED NATION.

CHRIS: HERE IN THE U-S, PAKISTAN IS BEING WATCHED CAREFULLY.

(SOT: CONDELEEZA RICE, Secretary of State) "IT IS IN THE EST INTEREST OF PAKISTAN AND THE PAKISTANI PEOPLE FOR THERE TO BE A PROMPT RETURN TO A CONSTITUTIONAL COURSE."

CHRIS: ONE REASON WHY PAKISTAN IS SO IMPORTANT IS IT'S LOCATION - PAKISTAN BORDERS CHINA, IRAN AND AFGHANISTAN - A HOT BED OF POLITICAL ACTIVITY.

CHRIS: CHRIS BROWNE, CHANNEL ONE NEWS.

ANNOUNCER: HOW MUCH DO YOU KNOW ABOUT THE REGION SURROUNDING PAKISTAN? PLAY GEO MASTER AT CHANNEL ONE DOT COM AND TEST YOUR KNOWLEDGE.

TONY: WHEN THIS BUILDING RIGHT HERE WAS TO BE MADE, THE SPOT THAT I AM STANDING AT WAS TO BE A PARKING LOT BUT INSTEAD A DISCOVERY WAS MADE. TONY: HUNDREDS OF AFRICAN-AMERICANS WERE FOUND BURIED RIGHT HERE. THOSE WHO HELPED BUILD NEW YORK CITY. NOW THERE'S IS AN ESTIMATED 15-20,000 STILL BURIED HERE, SO IN 2006 PRESIDENT BUSH MADE THIS A NATIONAL MONUMENT.

TONY: IN MANHATTAN, AN EMOTIONAL CEREMONY ON A SMALL PIECE OF LAND.

TONY: THIS LONG-AWAITED BURIAL GROUND MONUMENT HONORS SOME 20,000 PEOPLE OF AFRICAN DESCENT - MANY OF THEM SLAVES - WHO HISTORIANS BELIEVE DIED WHILE HELPING BUILD THIS CITY.

TONY: YES, SLAVERY IN THE NORTH WAS WIDESPREAD, SOMETHING MANY STILL DON'T REALIZE.

TONY: RODNEY LEON DESIGNED THE MEMORIAL. IT'S A CEREMONIAL CHAMBER DECORATED WITH TRIBAL SYMBOLS AND MARKERS REPRESENTING THE DEAD.

(SOT: Rodney Leon) "I had a personal struggle just to get to this point and it's nothing compared to the struggles of the people that were buried here had to go through."

TONY: SO DO YOU GUYS KNOW ABOUT THE AFRICAN BURIAL GROUND? ("NO.") DO YOU HAVE A MINUTE, DO YOU MIND LOOKING AT IT WITH ME? NO PROBLEM. LETS GO.

TONY: THIS BURIAL SITE, WHICH WAS CLOSED IN 17-94 AND THEN FORGOTTEN WAS THE FINAL RESTING PLACE FOR THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE OF AFRICAN DECENT - - WHO WERE NOT ALLOWED GRAVES ALONGSIDE WHITES.

TONY: OFFICIALS TOLD ME THE ARCHITECT DESIGNED THE ENTRANCE TO BE NARROW TO FEEL LIKE YOU WERE GOING ONTO A SLAVE SHIP WHICH WAS HOW THE SLAVES WERE BROUGHT TO AMERICA. DAVAUGHNN RICHARDSON WAS AMAZED AS SOON AS WE GOT INSIDE.

(SOT: Davaughnn Richardson) "I had no idea about this, I had heard about it from friends but I never knew where it was at actually.

(SOT: Edwin Lovell) "It's unbelievable right here."

TONY: WHAT WAS FOUND HERE WAS AMAZING.

(SOT - Unidentified woman) "Basically the whole thoracic region, from the upper--the first rib down to the last."

TONY: THE MORE THAN 400 SETS OF REMAINS FOUND HERE IN 1991 ARE BEING SENT TO HOWARD UNIVERSITY - IN WASHINGTON, D-C - WITH HOPES THAT THEY CAN FIND INSIGHT INTO THE LITTLE KNOWN LIVES AND DEATHS OF BLACKS IN THE NORTHERN UNITED STATES.

TONY: ARCHEOLOGIST BELIEVE THE CEMETARY IS ONE OF THE LARGEST OF ITS KIND. NEW YORK'S BLACK COMMUNITY FOUGHT TO HAVE CONSTRUCTION STOPPED ON TOP OF THE SITE.

(SOT:) "If you wanna know more about yourself, you come here. I'm gonna go home and look up some of this stuff when I get a chance to."

TONY: THE AFRICAN BURIAL GROUND IS ONE OF ONE HUNDRED AND THREE NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN THE COUNTRY, AND ONLY PRESIDENTS AND CONGRESS CAN DESIGNATE THEM. A TRIBUTE FITTING FOR THOSE WHO SPENT THEIR LIVES BUILDING NEW YORK CITY. TONY ANDERSON CHANNEL ONE NEWS.

ANNOUNCER: EXPLORE IMPORTANT EVENTS IN AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY. GO TO BLACK HISTORY AT CHANNEL ONE DOT COM AND TAKE THE QUIZ.

TONY: HERE'S MORE FROM OUR ONE VOICE SERIES SPONSORED BY THE KNIGHT FOUNDATION- ALL ABOUT YOU AND YOUR FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS.

TONY: NOW, THERE'S A NEW MAGAZINE IN ARLINGTON, TEXAS IS SETTING ASIDE THE GOSSIP AND GUY TALK TO TELL THE "REAL" STORY OF THE CITY'S GIRLS.

TONY: JESSICA KUMARI GIVES YOU AND INSIDE LOOK AT JOURNALISM AND FREEDOM OF THE PRESS.

JESSICA: WELCOME TO THE PLANNING MEETING FOR METRO GIRL MAGAZINE.

(nats) "I'm just going to show you guys before we get started - a little sneak peak"

JESSICA: PUBLISHER LAURA HEYMANN ((hay-man)) DREAMPT UP THE CONCEPT, BUT THE STORIES COME FROM YOUNGER VOICES.

(SOT: Laura Heymann / Metro Girl Magazine Publisher) "We have readers as young as eight and as old as 18. The writers range in age from 10 to 17."

(SOT: Trina Carpenter / Metro Girl Magazine Writer) "I did about the environment and how to help the environment."

JESSICA: FROM VOLUNTEERING, TO GIVING ADVICE, TO BEING BI-RACIAL - THE MAGAZINE IS AN INSIGHT INTO BEING A GIRL IN NORTH TEXAS.

(SOT: Laura Heymann) "I really think that the girls are interested in what we have to say and they're interested in being involved with it. They're all very, very excited about it and we're doing a lot of great things and that need wasn't being filled at all."

JESSICA: 15-YEAR-OLD TRINA IS A CONTRIBUTOR. ONE OF HER ARTICLES WAS ABOUT HOW TO DEAL WITH MEAN GIRLS.

(SOT: Trina Carpenter, Metro Girl Magazine Writer) "How to deal with girls at school if they're picking on you; how to help out other girls that get picked on too."

JESSICA: THE MAGAZINE IS EVEN MOM-APPROVED.

(SOT: MOM) "My daughter has been writing prolifically since she's been about 12 years old and I thought this might be something she really might be interested in."

(SOT: MOM #2) "She wants to be in the reporting field, she wants to be a writer. I thought this would be a good opportunity for her to get some experience. I wish I had something that I could read and say I could relate to that."

JESSICA: THE GIRLS ARE GLAD TO HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO WRITE AT SUCH A YOUNG AGE.

(SOT: Trina Carpenter, Metro Girl Magazine Writer) "I actually want to be a journalist. So, my mom told me about this and I think it's a good start."
